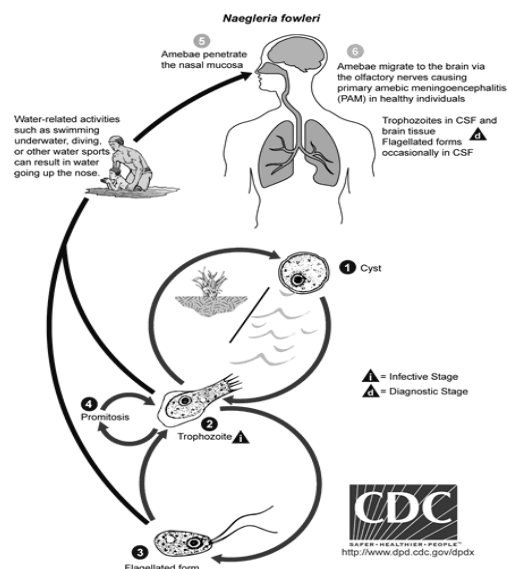


Are You Aware of the

Naegleria Fowleri is an amoeba that lives naturally in freshwater including lakes, rivers, ponds, and hot springs and recently found in neti-pots without distilled or previously boiled water. It thrives, multiplies and feeds on bacteria and becomes a life-threatening risk when the water temperature is near 80 degrees and warmer.

This amoeba enters the body through the nose during water activities and causes the infection Primary Amoebic Meningoencephalitis (PAM).
